Jensen A/S was a small construction company that my father owned, which I sold when my father got sick.</p> <p>After the financial crisis, my father and his two partners had severe loss in their company in two following years and something needed to be done. I took part in the company, made a new strategy and made it profitable again. We bought the partners out and scaled down the company focusing on profitable contracts and to make a more profitable contract/customer portfolio. I have been responsible for selling the company and sold the company may 2013.</p> <p>Did various administration tasks: Salary, tax filing, contact with bank and lawyer and bookkeeping,</p>
<p><b>2008 – 2010</b></p>	<p><b>Start-up of Eating ApS</b></p> <p>I was CEO and responsible for strategy and finance.</p> <p>Eating was a concept designed to compete with Just-Eat which had market monopoly at the time being. It was a two-way communication platform that should facilitate direct communication between the customer and restaurant, which was a new concept. We, two fellow students and me, developed the concept in close cooperation with different restaurants and pizzerias. The concept actually got pre-sold to 25 restaurants, financed with DDK 650,000 and the software developed. But, the finance was withdrawn by the bank only after 8 months due to the financial crisis, which caused bankruptcy.</p>

The union has over 80,000 members.</p> <p>My responsibilities were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Representation of political interests for 22,000 students including daily press contact.</li> <li>• Leader of the presidency and the board in Djøf Students with 150 volunteers and a DKK 2.1 million budget. Board member at Djøf counting 230 employees.</li> <li>• My main task were a merger with C3, where I was President at C3 Student at the time of the merger. I had the responsibility with the former President of Djøf Students to merge the organisations and make a new organisation and strategy. Shortly after the merger, I became the president; build the new organisation, created an education program, and developed leadership talents and my own successor. I could finally hand over a well-functioning organisation with a lot of talents and a great successor in 2013.</li> </ul>
